

Cargo/shipping containers: Other communities are considering an ordinance prohibiting or limiting the use of cargo/shipping containers for things such as sheds, living quarters or garages.

Short-term rental ordinance: Our Bed and Breakfast ordinance does not have sufficient language to address the growing number of short-term rentals that are popping up in other communities and potentially ours.

Nottingham Road condition: There are four properties on Nottingham Road. Three of them have annexed to Combined Locks. The road is in poor condition. Consider resurface project in 2025 with Park Street.

Storm Water Funds for private property: A few years ago, the Village Board voted against having a fund for private property owners to apply for grants to repair erosion problems on their properties. Reconsider.
