

Dear Parents:

Thank you for being part of the 2026 Combined Locks Baseball/Softball/Teeball Program! We are looking forward to a great summer!

Here are a few extra things you need to know and a few extra responsibilities for you:

1. Jerseys are included with your registration fee and will be printed with the name and number options you provided. We do our best to print one of the numbers you requested. **Please have players tuck in their jerseys.**
2. Helmets, bats and facemasks are provided. These items are shared with the teams and are sanitized at the end of each night. You may use your own.
3. Baseball bats must be stamped "USA Little League" approved.
4. Cleats are optional, but cleats with metal spikes are not allowed in any league.
5. **All baseball players 1st grade through 6th grade** must wear gray baseball pants. Hats are optional, but if a hat is worn, it must be the Combined Locks baseball hat.
6. **All softball players 1st grade through 8th grade** must wear black baseball pants or black athletic shorts. Yoga pants, leggings and spandex shorts are not acceptable unless worn under black baseball pants or black athletic shorts. Hats or visors are optional, but if one is worn, it must be the Combined Locks hat or visor. Facemasks are required for all players on the infield.
7. **Teeball players** must wear gray or black baseball pants or gray or black athletic shorts (yoga pants and spandex shorts are not acceptable). Hats or visors are optional, but if one is worn, it must be the Combined Locks hat or visor.
8. Hats, visors, and pants are available to purchase at the park shelter once practices begin (hopefully the week of April 12th). We have a limited supply of pants. **Clothing will not be available for sale at the ballpark once games start.** Get your stuff now!
9. **Dogs are not allowed at the baseball fields! Please share this information with friends and family who may be attending a game.**
10. We have one of the best ballpark food stands in the area 😊. It is managed by the Combined Locks Advancement Association. This 100% volunteer group uses the profits from the concession stand to improve parks in Combined Locks, sponsor Project Graduation, sponsor Eagle Scout and Girl Scout projects, and award \$3,000 to \$5,000 in scholarships each year. **One parent is required to work one shift for each child they have in the program. Those working in the concession stand must be 18 years old or older.** Shifts are typically 1.75 hours long. We use SignUpGenius so you can choose your shift instead of having it assigned to you. The SignUpGenius schedule will be emailed to everyone on April 10th.
Please do your part – do not put more burden on others by not signing up for your shift(s).
